
1. Please log into ESS (Employee Self-Service) system



If you are already registered for MBOS, you can log on using the Login button wherever you see "Access My MBOS Account."













# Retirement: How, What, and Where

The Teachers' Pension and Annuity Fund (TPAF) is a defined benefit pension fund established 1919, reorganized in 1955 and open to employees of boards of education and the State who must I certified or credentialed as a condition of employment. Membership in the TPAF for employe who meet eligibility requirements is mandatory.

#### Pension

You must be enrolled in the pension plan, according to the <u>Tier Chart</u> and life insurance plan as condition of your employment. Pension contributions at 7.5% are mandatory.

#### **Retirement Planning**

Planning to retire? Learn and choose financial strategies that enable you to be comfortable and secure in your retirement years. A good retirement plan, executed smartly, can provide you with enough money to cover all of your later-year living expenses. ## **Benefits Retirement Highlight**

- The employee's active coverage ends effective the that same date of the retirement and their retirement benefits become effective the date of the retirement. For example, if an employee retires effective July 1, their coverage ends with the Newark Board of Education effective July 1 and their retirement health benefit coverage becomes effective July 1 with the retiree health benefits plan.
- To determine your pension payout, run an estimate. (details on the next slide)

## Free Retiree Benefits Only apply


• State employees with 20 or more years of service credit as of June 28, 2011 (the effective date of Chapter 78, P.L. 2011) are grandfathered at a 1.5% contribution for post-retirement health benefit coverage — but must attain 25 years of pension service credit prior to retirement to qualify for any employer or State-paid contributions toward post-retirement health benefit costs.

- Retirement estimates show how much your gross monthly retirement benefit will be. The
  estimate can also include the amount for a survivor benefit after your death, your group life
  insurance benefit after retirement, and other important information about your retirement
  benefits.

## **Sick Day Buyback**

#### What do I need to do?

This is an automatic process, you do not need to take any action.

#### When will I get paid?

For July 1 Retirements, you will receive payment by August 1.

# Will I Paid through Direct Deposit?

Sick Buy Back Payments are paid through a paper check. Please make sure your address is correct when you retire.


#### **How Much?**

The amount will depend on how many accrued and unused days you have. Click <u>here</u> for the formula.\*

- \* Your retirement notification date will impact the payout amount.
  - -Notice by April 1 to receive full payout
  - -Sweeteners for notification given before February 15 or December 1
  - -Reduced payout for notifications after April 1
